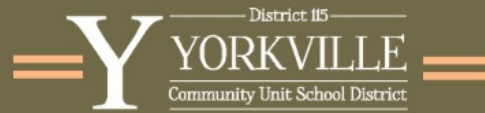

Changes made to the district's Wellness Policy

On Monday, April 26, the Yorkville CUSD 115 Board of Education approved changes to Policy 6:50 – School Wellness, in order to comply with the requirements of the federal National School Lunch Program and Illinois State Board of Education.

The most significant change to the district's wellness policy is that starting in the 2019-2020 school year, food and beverages can no longer be provided to students as a reward or as part of a celebration.

ALLOWED:

- food (including snacks) consumed during the school day that a parent/guardian provides for his/her own child
- food that is part of the district's curriculum
- food that is part of a student's Individualized Education Plan or medical plan
- food provided after normal school day hours

NOT ALLOWED:

- food that is used as a reward (e.g., a pizza party as a classroom prize)
- food that is part of a celebration (e.g., snacks distributed as part of a holiday celebration)
