- Las celebraciones comienzan a las 2:25 hasta el final del día.


Los estudiantes pueden usar su disfraz todo el día. Las pautas de vestuario son las siguientes:




# ACES Parent Drop Off MAP



# ACES Parent Drop Off MAP

- ✦ Parents will enter the line off of Autumn Creek Blvd on the south side of the school
- ✦ A staff member will be at the south side of the building with a stop sign. This staff member will direct you to move forward
- ✦ When you enter there are two lanes to choose from.
  - ✦ The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
  - ✦ The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- ✦ Once in the unloading zones, pull all the way forward
- ✦ Student can exit the car once signaled to do so by the ACES staff member
- ✦ Students in zones 1 and 2 should enter through the door marked #5 on the map
- ✦ Students in zones 3 and 4 should enter through the door marked #4 on the map
- ✦ All cars will wait to exit until all students have cleared the unloading zone
- ✦ A staff member at the exit will signal when it is safe to leave
  - ✦ The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
  - ✦ The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- ✦ This process will be repeated as the next set of cars line up in the two lanes

- ✦ Parents will enter the line off of Autumn Creek Blvd on the south side of the school.
- ✦ A staff member will be at the south side of the building with a stop sign. This staff member will direct you to move forward.

  - ✦ The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.

- ✦ Once in the pick-up zones, pull all the way forward.
- ✦ As students exit the building at 3:35, they will be directed to find their car and enter it if it is in zones 1-4.
- ✦ All cars will wait to exit until all students are safely in their cars.
- ✦ A staff member at the exit will signal when it is safe to leave.
  - ✦ The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
  - ✦ The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- ✦ This process will be repeated as the next set of cars line up in the two lanes.


