October Bullying Prevention Month

I am delighted to inform you that this month marks "Bullying Prevention Month" at our school. As part of our commitment to raising awareness and promoting a safe and respectful school environment, we have organized a special initiative for our students.

Each Thursday throughout this month, we invite our students to participate by wearing a designated color that represents different aspects of bullying prevention. You can find the specific color for each week in the image provided below.

In our efforts to educate and empower our students, we have designed a comprehensive curriculum. Throughout the month, your child will engage with specific bullying-related topics and discussions.

This week, they have already delved into the fundamental concepts of what constitutes bullying, including distinguishing it from behaviors like being mean or rude.

To gain deeper insights into what your child is learning in school, we encourage you to explore the linked "Parent Connection" resources. These materials will provide you with valuable information about the lessons and discussions taking place in the classroom.

Week one: Parent Bullying Prevention Information

Here are some steps you can take at home to further reinforce the message and encourage open discussions with your child:

- Read the provided parent connection materials: Take the time to thoroughly review the materials shared by the school to understand what specific topics and concepts were covered during the week. This will help you align your conversations with what your child learned at school.
- Discuss the difference between being mean, rude, and bullying: As your child learned about these distinctions during the week, have a conversation about what each of these behaviors entails. Encourage them to share their thoughts and experiences, if any, and provide guidance on how to handle these situations.
- Share personal stories and experiences: Share any personal experiences you or family members may have had with bullying or related issues. This can help your child relate to the topic and understand that they can always talk to you if they encounter such situations.
- Reinforce empathy and kindness: Emphasize the importance of treating others with respect, kindness, and empathy. Discuss ways your child can support classmates and friends who may be experiencing bullying or unkind behavior.

Throughout Bullying Prevention Month, continue to engage with your child on the different topics and encourage them to wear the designated colors on Thursdays to show their support for the cause. This collaborative effort between the school and parents can help create a safer and more empathetic school environment.

Octubre Mes de la Prevención del Bullying

Me complace informarles que este mes se celebra el "Mes de la prevención del acoso" en nuestra escuela. Como parte de nuestro compromiso de concientiar y promover un ambiente escolar seguro y respetuoso, hemos organizado una iniciativa especial para nuestros alumnos.

Cada jueves a lo largo de este mes, invitamos a nuestros estudiantes a participar vistiendo un color designado que represente diferentes aspectos de la prevención del acoso. Puede encontrar el color específico para cada semana en la imagen que se proporciona a

continuación.

En nuestros esfuerzos por educar y empoderar a nuestros estudiantes, hemos diseñado un plan de estudios integral. A lo largo del mes, su hijo participará en temas y debates específicos relacionados con el acoso. Esta semana ya han profundizado en los conceptos fundamentales de lo que constituye acoso, incluso distinguirlo de comportamientos como ser malo o grosero.

Para obtener una visión más profunda de lo que su hijo está aprendiendo en la escuela, lo alentamos a explorar los recursos vinculados "Parent Connection". Estos materiales le proporcionarán información valiosa sobre las lecciones y debates que tienen lugar en el aula.

Semana uno: Información para padres sobre la prevención del acoso

Aquí hay algunos pasos que puede seguir en casa para reforzar aún más el mensaje y fomentar discusiones abiertas con su hijo:

- Lea los materiales de conexión para padres proporcionados: Tómese el tiempo para revisar minuciosamente los materiales compartidos por la escuela para comprender qué temas y conceptos específicos se cubrieron durante la semana. Esto le ayudará a alinear sus conversaciones con lo que su hijo aprendió en la escuela.
- Discuta la diferencia entre ser malo, grosero y acosador: a medida que su hijo aprenda sobre estas distinciones durante la semana, converse sobre lo que implica cada uno de estos comportamientos. Anímelos a compartir sus pensamientos y experiencias, si las hubiera, y bríndeles orientación sobre cómo manejar estas situaciones.
- Comparta historias y experiencias personales: comparta cualquier experiencia personal que usted o sus familiares hayan tenido con el acoso o problemas relacionados. Esto puede ayudar a su hijo a identificarse con el tema y comprender que siempre puede hablar con usted si se encuentra en situaciones de este tipo.
- Reforzar la empatía y la amabilidad: enfatizar la importancia de tratar a los demás con respeto, amabilidad y empatía. Analice las formas en que su hijo puede apoyar a sus compañeros de clase y amigos que puedan estar sufriendo acoso o comportamiento desagradable.

Durante el Mes de la Prevención del Bullying, continúe interactuando con su hijo sobre los diferentes temas y anímelos a usar los colores designados los jueves para mostrar su apoyo a la causa. Este esfuerzo de colaboración entre la escuela y los padres puede ayudar a crear un ambiente escolar más seguro y empático.

Los estudiantes pueden usar su disfraz todo el día. Las pautas de vestuario son las siguientes:


- Los disfraces no deben cubrir la cara.

Great news! Our school has partnered with Smile Programs...the mobile dentists to offer in-school dental care. Applications were sent home. Please send them back and have your child(ren) turn application to their teacher if interested.

Even better, dental care is usually at no cost to you. All insurance is accepted including Medicaid and CHIP. For those without insurance, a low cost self-pay option is available.

Our in-school dental program saves you time and provides a safe and comfortable place for your child to receive gentle dental care from licensed local professionals. Dental care includes a complete dental exam, x-rays, cleaning, fluoride and sealants when necessary, and in some cases, restorative care such as fillings.

Children who see a dentist regularly may have fewer health issues like: Early tooth loss due to dental decay Gum disease Heart disease Impaired speech development Help keep your child healthy, in school and learning. Simply go to www.myschooldentist.com for more information.

Aún mejor, la atención dental generalmente no tiene costo para usted. Se aceptan todos los seguros, incluidos Medicaid y CHIP. Para quienes no tienen seguro, está disponible una opción de pago por cuenta propia de bajo costo.

Nuestro programa dental en la escuela le ahorra tiempo y brinda un lugar seguro y cómodo para que su hijo reciba atención dental amable por parte de profesionales locales autorizados. 
Procedimientos de Tránsito ACES


ACES Parent Drop Off MAP

- Parents will enter the line off of Autumn Creek Blvd on the south side of the school
- A staff member will be at the south side of the building with a stop sign. This staff member will direct you to move forward
- When you enter there are two lanes to choose from.
 - The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
 - The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- Once in the unloading zones, pull all the way forward
- Student can exit the car once signaled to do so by the ACES staff member
- Students in zones 1 and 2 should enter through the door marked #5 on the map
- Students in zones 3 and 4 should enter through the door marked #4 on the map
- All cars will wait to exit until all students have cleared the unloading zone
- A staff member at the exit will signal when it is safe to leave
 - The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
 - The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- This process will be repeated as the next set of cars line up in the two lanes

- Parents will enter the line off of Autumn Creek Blvd on the south side of the school.
- A staff member will be at the south side of the building with a stop sign. This staff member will direct you to move forward.
- When you enter there are two lanes to choose from.

 - The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- Once in the pick-up zones, pull all the way forward.
- As students exit the building at 3:35, they will be directed to find their car and enter it if it is in zones 1-4.
- All cars will wait to exit until all students are safely in their cars.
- A staff member at the exit will signal when it is safe to leave.
 - The **Right Lane** will exit by turning **right** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
 - The **Left Lane** will exit by turning **left** onto Prairie Grass Lane.
- This process will be repeated as the next set of cars line up in the two lanes.
