

YMS Wrestling is open to all Yorkville CUSD 115 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade students. Wrestling does not have cuts and welcomes both boys and girls to join. There is a Junior Varsity and Varsity squad, so your child will face other wrestlers that are at a similar skill level.

We are a developmental program with our main goal being to prepare our wrestlers for success at the high school level by instilling work ethic and fundamentals that are essential to the sport of wrestling.

YMS wrestling is a member of the Illinois Elementary School Association (IESA), which allows individual wrestlers to compete in the state tournament beginning with a regional tournament. The top 3 place winners in the regional tournament will advance to a sectional tournament, with the top 4 sectional place winners advancing to the state tournament. 



Drop-off boxes for submissions will be located in the Main Office. Please make sure your name is on it. Winners will be announced after winter break. Happy drawing and good luck!





