

What is DDX3X?


DDX3X Syndrome is a rare disease caused by a spontaneous mutation on the DDX3X gene. The syndrome was discovered in the United States in 2014 and primarily affects girls due to its location on the X-chromosome. Although it has only been identified in nearly 1,000 individuals, doctors believe it is the cause of 1 to 3 percent of all intellectual disabilities in females. Symptoms vary among individuals, but some common symptoms are developmental disability, speech delay, gross & fine motor challenges, and epilepsy.

Why Fundraise for the Foundation?

Research on rare diseases is primarily funded by patient groups. The DDX3X Foundation is currently funding 6 different research projects across the United States. All money the foundation receives goes directly towards research with the goal of finding a treatment for DDX3X!



BPAC is excited to sponsor two events for the end of the school year.


1. BPAC meeting at ACES from 7-8:30 p.m. in the library. The focus is how parents can support their children in math. Child supervision will be provided.


