

News from Nurse Abbey

Illinois state law requires every student attending an Illinois school to have documented proof of a physical examination and specific immunizations on file with the school. According to the law, students are to be excluded from school for failure to meet these requirements. A physical exam dated within one year (8/24/22) of the start of school is required for students entering **early childhood** and **kindergarten**.

Students who do not have this information turned in by October 1st, 2023 will be excluded from school. Please contact Nurse Abbey with any questions or concerns at aartman@y115.org.

DROP OFF & PICK UP



Please review the reminders below to ensure that all students and parents are safe during pick up and drop off.
