Taking care of your child's teeth is an important part of keeping them healthy





PSAT Testing on October 25. 8th grade students only.

8th Grade Families - On Wednesday, Oct. 25 all 8th grade students will be taking the College Board PSAT 8/9 assessment. Students will take the digital test with their Advisory teacher or case manager, and testing will be from 7:30 am - 11:00 am.

This is the first test in the SAT Suite of Assessments, and the data from this test is used by YMS and YHS to help your child with needed intervention or enrichment opportunities, summer school classes, and course selection for high school.

Please remind your student to bring their charged Chromebook and charger to school Thursday morning, as well as to get a good night's rest the night before and have a healthy breakfast the morning of.

Thank you for helping us provide a more comfortable and welcoming environment for our YMS students!






