Message from the Deans

Expectations were reviewed with students during Wednesday's grade-level presentations in the auditorium. We highlighted some "shout-outs" of student behaviors such as: Following cell phone & wireless earbud expectations and putting backpacks in designated areas in the classroom.

One topic that was discussed was peer interactions. Some students have the tendency to "joke" with one another. Some examples are taking a peer's hat, phone, or other types of horesplaying. It was reminded that they can be held responsible if that item was lost or damaged. It was also explained that we cannot control how others will react, but we can control how we react.

We reinforced how students can ask a staff member or student service for help, and how to use the student service Google form if they are experiencing any peer issues. Additionally, we also have the Y Not Say Something tipline for outside school hours.





A \$150.00 donation will cover the cost of half of a bench and you will share a personalized plaque with one other donor.


A \$25.00-125.00 donation will be used toward the purchase of a bench. No matter the amount, you will make a significant difference in reaching our goal!
