# The Math Team competes in the SPC Tournament!



### End of the Semester is here!

All semester grades will be finalized by February 8, 2024. Once the last assessment grade is entered for

a class, parents/students will be able to see their final semester grade. These can be viewed by clicking on the Classes icon in the Home Access Center (HAC). Students are able to retake the last assessment at their request (after completing required re-learning) and must sign up for the Den/Testing Center on their own. All retakes must be completed prior to February 8th.

First semester grades will be posted under the Grades icon on February 9, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. Please understand that report cards include G.P.A., credits and Honor Roll calculations. The Grade Point Average (GPA) listed is a weighted GPA that means students who took honors/Advanced Placement (with some additions) receive an additional grade point for a grade of C or better. For example, a student who received a "B" in English 1 Honors would earn 4.0 grade points versus a student who earned a "B" in English 1 who would receive 3.0 grade points.

### Seniors - The FAFSA is a Graduation Requirement! Don't Delay ~ Complete it Today!

Senior Families: Completing the FAFSA or the FAFSA waiver is an Illinois state high school graduation requirement—in order to graduate, you MUST complete it! The FAFSA is the *free* application for federal student aid, that must be completed to



qualify for federal grants, state grants, and institutional scholarships provided by colleges and universities. Remember, grant money is obtained by completing the FAFSA on a <u>first come</u>, <u>first served basis!</u> The FAFSA application is open now!

\*all students must complete the FAFSA or the Waiver by May 1, 2024, as required by the state of Illinois for graduation.
