

Congratulations! Yorkville High School has earned Silver recognition on the 2023 AP School Honor Roll and the National AP Access Award.

I am excited to announce that Yorkville High School has earned the College Board's Silver Recognition AP School Honor Roll for the 2022-23 school year! The AP School


Honor Roll recognizes schools that have done outstanding work to welcome more students into AP courses and support them on the path to college success. The Silver Honor Roll distinction is based on three categories:

- College Culture determined by the percentage of students in the graduating class (2023) who
 took an AP exam at any point in high school, regardless of score. Last year, 51% of the Class of
 2023 took at least one AP exam at YHS.
- College Credit determined by the percentage of students in the graduating class (2023) who scored 3+ on any AP Exam in high school. 33% of the graduating class scored a 3 or higher on at least one AP exam.
- College Optimization determined by the percentage of students in the graduating class who took 5 or more AP Exams in high school, where at least 1 exam was taken in 9th or 10th grade. 13% of the graduating class achieved this metric.

In addition, Yorkville High School also earned the **AP Access Award**, which honors schools that encourage more <u>low-income and underrepresented minority students</u> to take AP courses. The AP Access Award acknowledges the percentage of students in at least one of these categories who took at least one AP Exam before graduation proportional to or above your school's student population, demonstrating a clear and compelling commitment to equitable access to advanced coursework.

It takes a considerable schoolwide effort—dedication from teachers, counselors, administrators, students, and parents to earn both recognitions. I sincerely appreciate and congratulate our students, families, staff, and AP teachers for their inspiring work and commitment. Well done, Foxes!




Boys Golfers Compete at Sectionals!




Activities Update

SAVE the DATE - PSAT/NMSQT Assessment on October 18th

Yorkville High School (YHS) is excited to announce that we will provide our freshmen, sophomores, and juniors the opportunity to take the College Board Suite of Assessments in the new digital format on the Bluebook Application On Wednesday, October 18th. Yorkville School District purchased a PSAT 8/9 for all 9th-grade students and a PSAT National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT) for all 10th and 11th-grade students.

Parent Teacher Conferences

As a reminder, this year's fall parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for Thursday, November 9th from 12:00 - 7:00 PM and Friday, November 10th from 7:10 - 11:10 AM. This is a great opportunity to meet with your child's teachers for a ten-minute conference.

You can schedule appointments online using the PTC Wizard System from October 6th at 7:00 a.m. through November 6th at 7:00 p.m. This opportunity is available at any time of day or

night. We have been assured that as many as 6,000 families could schedule simultaneously without overloading the system.

You may make appointments with as many or as few teachers as you wish. Please understand that we built in a 5-minute transition between conferences to keep our teachers on schedule. Also, for those new to this process, all conferences are held in the YHS gymnasium.

Keep in mind that, in some instances, ten minute conferences are not adequate. If you find yourself in that situation, you may make an appointment with that teacher for a follow-up conference or a phone conference at a later date. If one of the teachers has a full schedule, you may contact the teacher through email and arrange a time to talk about your child's progress in a particular class.

This year's conferences will offer our families the option to conduct their conference in-person or virtually. Families interested in an virtual conference should include a note stating "Virtual Conference" in the comment section when you schedule your student(s) conferences. If no note is added to the comment section indicates the conference will be "in-person". Individual teacher zoom links will be sent out the week of November 6th.

You can access the PTC Wizard website by following the steps below. Once you have completed registration, you will be guided through a step-by-step procedure which allows you to choose from your child's teachers' available time slots. If you do not know the names of your child's teachers, I encourage you to retrieve that information from the Home Access Center.

In order to register on the PTC Wizard parent website, please proceed with the following:

- Open the link https://app.ptcwizard.com/yorkville and click on Create Account! button. Previously registered parents should use their credentials, or forgot password option.
- Fill out the form you are redirected to. Type in your first name, last name, email address and a password you would like to use to log in to PTC Wizard.
- Once you click on Register, you will be redirected to Add A Child for. Fill it out and hit Save.
- In case you would like to add more than one child, you will be able to do so in Account settings once you log in (right top corner of the screen).
- After you hit Save, you will be prompted to give your consent to receive letters from the system via email (schedules, notifications about appointments being booked/canceled, etc.)
- After creating a log in, you can view the video tutorial for more assistance.

After you create a conference schedule for yourself, the details of your schedule will automatically be emailed to you. If you do not have internet access, please contact Mrs. VanDenBosch 630.553.4380 extension 4375. Thank you for your continued support and cooperation.
