Athletics Update

Girls Cross Country place 9th and Boys 16th at the IHSA State Meet!

Congratulations to the cross country program on yet another fantastic season. Both the girls and boys teams competed in the State Finals at Detweiller Park on Saturday, November 4th. The girls team placed 9th which marked the 14th consecutive year that the girls have placed in the top 10 in the state. The girls finished the season as Conference Champions, Regional, and Sectional Champions. The boys 16th place finish was the best finish the boys have had since being moved up to the state's largest 3A division. Congratulations to all of the cross country athletes and coaches!





Girls Swim & Dive finish season at IHSA Sectionals this weekend!

Girls swimming and diving finished out their season with every athlete performing a season best time at Sectionals, held at Neuqua Valley High School this past Saturday, November 4th. The competition started out with the diving portion where Sophomore, Caitlyn Seliga advanced to the finals finishing 5th with a score of 394.05; eleven points short of qualifying for State. Caitlyn, in her eleven dives had six career high scores

with one dive scoring above 50 points. To kick off the swimming competition, the Medley Relay consisting of Emily Vollmer, Payton Drent, an IMSA swimmer and Abby Ziegler dropped over 4 seconds with a season best time of 2:02.24. Taylor Corrado followed in the 200 Freestyle and scored a personal best of 2:18.50. Vollmer swam the 200 Individual Medley in a season best time of 2:24:85. The 50 Freestyle swam by Ziegler in a season best time of 27.10 and Arabella Aug with a personal best time of 28.99. The 100 Butterfly saw additional time drops with a personal best time by Drent with a 1:06.03 and a season best time of 1:14.42 by Arabella Aug. The 100 Freestyle saw one seasonal best time swum by Eileen Baltes with a 1:05.89 and a personal best tie for Ziegler with a 59.37. A personal best swim was completed by Adrianna Sanchez in the 500 freestyle with a time of 6:59:12. The 200 free relay team included Foxes Keira Maratea and Aug scored a season best 1:53.96. In the 100 Backstroke Vollmer swam a personal best with a 1:06.79 and Drent 1:10.30. To close out the swimming competition, the 400 Freestyle Relay competed by Drent, Ziegler, an IMSA athlete and Vollmer had a massive time drop of 18 seconds for a season best time of 4:07.96. Congratulations, swim and divers on a fantastic season!




Holiday Coat Drive!
