Parent Teacher Conferences

As a reminder, this year's fall parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for Thursday, November 9th from 12:00 - 7:00 PM and Friday, November 10th from 7:10 - 11:10 AM. This is a great opportunity to meet with your child's teachers for a ten-minute conference.



You can schedule appointments online using the PTC Wizard System from October 6th at 7:00 a.m. through November 6th at 7:00 p.m. This opportunity is available at any time of day or night. We have been assured that as many as 6,000 families could schedule simultaneously without overloading the system.

You may make appointments with as many or as few teachers as you wish. Please understand that we built in a 5-minute transition between conferences to keep our teachers on schedule. Also, for those new to this process, all conferences are held in the YHS gymnasium.

Keep in mind that, in some instances, ten minute conferences are not adequate. If you find yourself in that situation, you may make an appointment with that teacher for a follow-up conference or a phone conference at a later date. If one of the teachers has a full schedule, you may contact the teacher through email and arrange a time to talk about your child's progress in a particular class.

If you speak a language other than English and would like an interpreter for Parent-Teacher Conferences, fill out this request form.

This year's conferences will offer our families the option to conduct their conference in-person or virtually. Families interested in an virtual conference should include a note stating "Virtual Conference" in the comment section when you schedule your student(s) conferences. If no note is added to the comment section indicates the conference will be "in-person". Individual teacher zoom links will be sent out the week of November 6th.

You can access the PTC Wizard website by following the steps below. Once you have completed registration, you will be guided through a step-by-step procedure which allows you to choose from your child's teachers' available time slots. If you do not know the names of your child's teachers, I encourage you to retrieve that information from the Home Access Center.

In order to register on the PTC Wizard parent website, please proceed with the following:

- Open the link https://app.ptcwizard.com/yorkville and click on Create Account! button. Previously registered parents should use their credentials, or forgot password option.
- Fill out the form you are redirected to. Type in your first name, last name, email address and a
 password you would like to use to log in to PTC Wizard.
- Once you click on Register, you will be redirected to Add A Child for. Fill it out and hit Save.
- In case you would like to add more than one child, you will be able to do so in Account settings once you log in (right top corner of the screen).
- After you hit Save, you will be prompted to give your consent to receive letters from the system
 via email (schedules, notifications about appointments being booked/canceled, etc.)
- After creating a log in, you can view the <u>video tutorial</u> for more assistance.

After you create a conference schedule for yourself, the details of your schedule will automatically be emailed to you. If you do not have internet access, please contact Mrs. VanDenBosch 630.553.4380 extension 4375. Thank you for your continued support and cooperation.



Athletics Update

Boys and Girls Cross Country Advance to the IHSA State Meet! Girls Win Sectional Title!

The boys and girls cross country teams competed in the IHSA Sectional at Granite City High School on Saturday, October 28th and both teams earned a trip to the State Finals! The Foxes varsity girls claimed a Sectional title scoring 73 team points led by Sophia Keeler's 6th place time of 17:27.28. Annabelle Reeder placed 10th in 17:35.11, Ashley Schraeder 15th in 17:55.09, Allegra Triner 20th in 18:01.64, and Liliana Camargo 23rd in 18:03.83! The boys placed 6th in route to advancing to the State Finals and ere

led by Owen Horeni's 9th place finish in 14:43.68. Jake Younger placed 25th in 15:01.89, Brody Greyer 52nd in 15:27.79, Ryan Rotramel 53rd in 15:30.06, and Ben Kieffer in 58th with a time of 15:34.97. YHS Fall Play - Ghostlight: November 3-4


More than twenty students have been hard at work on the YHS fall play *Ghostlight* which will take the stage on Friday, November 3, and Saturday, November 4.
