I hope this update finds you well.

Pasted below is an email I received from Mr. Ron Lear, Plainfield North High School's Athletic Director sharing his appreciation for an act of tremendous generosity and compassion by our Boys Basketball program and Head Coach John Holakovsky.

"Gentlemen, I would like to send my sincere thank you on something your Boys Varsity Basketball coach John Holakovsky did last night



Here is what happened last night.

My coach Bob Krahulik spoke with Coach Holakovsky before the game about a possibility. He asked him if we were down big at the end of the game, would he be ok with letting my manager shoot a shot. I explained to him that my manager is a boy with Autism who has tried out every year, and each time he got cut he wanted to be the manager, a great kid. He said sure, but you won't be down big.

Surprisingly, we had a sizable lead where each team's starters were out of the game. With 1:00 left I put our manager in. John called time out with 45 seconds left to tell his players to tell his players to let him get the ball and shoot, score, drive, etc, and to let him go. We fouled to put your team to the line so we could get the ball back. When we got the ball back, we gave the ball to our manager, who was shell shocked as we told him to shoot. After holding it for 2 seconds he ended up driving and making a layup. We have never seen him happier.

This truly was heartwarming and I am thankful that your coach was on board with this. It truly was a class act, and the Plainfield North administration and basketball team is very appreciative.

Yorkville High School has always been a first class act due to the leadership in that school. Your students are lucky to have both of you! Keep up the good work and please praise your coach today. He is an excellent coach and a great role model for his players. Him and I had a great talk before the game and he truly is a class act."



Family and Community Engagement - Parent Workshop


This is the F.A.C.E. Workshop you don't want to miss!

Seniors - The FAFSA is a Graduation Requirement! Don't Delay ~ Complete it Today!

Senior Families: Completing the FAFSA or the FAFSA waiver is an

Illinois state high school graduation requirement--in order to graduate, you MUST complete it! The FAFSA is the *free* application for federal student aid, that must be completed to qualify for federal grants, state grants, and institutional scholarships provided by colleges and universities. Remember, grant money is obtained by completing the FAFSA on a <u>first come</u>, <u>first served basis!</u> The FAFSA application is open now! *all students must complete the FAFSA or the Waiver by May 1, 2024, as required by the state of Illinois for graduation.
