## Girls Basketball Season Ends in Regional Final!

The Girls Basketball Program had a wonderful season at all three levels. Varsity ended up 22-10 overall breaking a 6 season streak of not reaching the 20 win column. They were 13-3 in conference which was good for 2nd place which is their highest finish since joining the SPC. Other highlights from the season include their best defensive effort coming against Joliet Central and holding them to only 15 points. The best offensive effort came in the Regional semi-final where the team scored 72 points and won by 18 against rival Plainfield North after beating them by just 7 points five days earlier. Our lower levels also had spectacular seasons with JV going 24-5 overall and 13-3 in conference and Freshman going 25-4 overall and 13-2 in conference.

## Boys Wrestling Claims 5 All-State Wrestlers!

Congratulations to the Varsity Boys Wrestlers that qualified and competed in last weekend's Class 3A Individual State Finals. The Foxes brought home 5 AllState wrestlers after 3 grueling days of wrestling at the State Farm Center at the University of Illinois in Champaign. Ryder Janeczko placed 6th at 157 lbs, Jack Ferguson 5th at 150 lbs , Luke Zook 5th at 175 lbs , Luke Chrisse 5th at 190 lbs , and Ben Alvarez 3rd at 215 lbs.


## Boys Wrestling Wins Dual Team Sectional, Advances to IHSA Quarterfinals!

Congratulations to the Boys Wrestling team on winning the Dual Team Sectional match against Edwardsville on Tuesday, February 20th. The Foxes traveled to Taylorville High School for the match and came away with a 37-17 win. The Foxes received wins from Liam Fenoglio, Daniel Martino, Nathan Craft, Dom Recchia, Van Rosauer, Jack Ferguson, Ryder Janeczko, Luke Zook, Luke Chrisse, and Ben Alvarez. The Foxes compete in the IHSA Quarterfinals on Friday, February 23rd at 7:00 p.m. against Naperville Central at the Grossinger Motors Arena in Bloomington.

The IMSA/Yorkville boys Swim Team had a fantastic showing at this year's Sectionals meet held at Metea Valley High School. Our boys recorded 16 season individual best times and team bests for the 200 Medley and 400 Freestyle relays.

On the diving team Zach Collins-Dornink scored a personal best of 240.95 , placing 8 th overall. To kick off the swimming portion
 of the meet, Quinn Kauffold swam a personal best in the 200 freestyle (1:57.00) and 500 freestyle (5:11.22). Next, Chase Kauffold raced to two personal best times in the 200 individual medley ( $2: 19.44$ ) and 100 breaststroke (1:13.04). Mattson Uhlenhopp swam two personal best times, one in the 50 freestyle (22.44) placing 12th overall and 100 freestyle (51.36) placing 14th. Following the first break, Tim Campbell raced in the 100 butterfly (1:00.11) and 100 breaststroke ( $1: 12.90$ ) nearly tying his personal best times.

The IMSA/YHS team also had Carson Converse qualify for the State Championship meet in the 200 individual medley with a time of 1:54.32 placing 5th overall and the 100 backstroke with a time of 52.85 placing 4th.

Congratulations to all our swimmers and divers on an incredible season and good luck to Carson Converse next week at State!

The Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy is a pathway for multilingual students to earn college credits by meeting State requirements.

The language test to meet the Seal requirement is coming up. ALL students currently enrolled in Spanish or German classes level III or higher and those in Heritage Spanish I or II will be taking this test during the school day for FREE. Testing dates will vary depending on the course and will be communicated to students during class. The testing window will be March - May.

Current EL students who would like to take the Seal of Biliteracy test can also sign up to take the test for FREE. Students will need to fill out this form and return it to Mrs. Olsen by

All other students who speak another language but are not currently enrolled in Spanish / German III or higher and are not a current EL student can choose to take the Seal of Biliteracy test. The student will need to fill out this form and return it to Mrs. Olsen. The cost will be $\$ 20$ and can be paid with cash or a check written out to Yorkville High School. Forms will be due by March 8.
