Allegra Triner and Dominic Vashkelis-Benson Receive IHSA Academic All-State Recognitions!

On Wednesday, February 21, 2024, the IHSA announced the 26 members who were selected to the 2024 IHSA All-State Academic Team. Nearly 500 nominations were received from IHSA member schools, and Allegra Triner was one of twenty-six students selected by a committee of high school administrators who

had the difficult task of evaluating all of the worthy candidates for the prestigious award. <u>Allegra is the first Yorkville High School student to ever make 1st Team Academic All-State</u>. Allegra will be recognized at a banquet in Bloomington on Monday, April 8, 2024. In addition, <u>Dominic Vashkelis Benson was one of fifty students selected by the evaluation committee</u>. Being awarded Honorable Mention status is something that YHS and Dominic should take great pride in. Congratulations to both Dominic and Allegra on this fantastic achievement!

Athletics Update

Boys Wrestling Placed 2nd in Class 3A at the IHSA State Meet!

This year's Varsity wrestling team had a historic season. The Foxes finished with a record of 22-5, most wins in school history, first in the Southwest Prairie Conference, won a Team Regional, won a Dual Team Sectional, qualified 12 athletes for individual sectionals and had 6 boys wrestlers represent Yorkville in Champaign at the Individual State Finals, bringing home 5 All-State Wrestlers! The wrestling team competed last weekend in the IHSA Dual Team State



Finals and came home as the IHSA Runner Up in Class 3A. Congratulations to all of the wrestlers, coaches, and families on a wonderful season!

Girls Wrestling Competes at IHSA Individual State Meet!

Dani Turner and Yami Aguirre represented the Girls Wrestling program at the IHSA State Meet held on February 23 and 24th at Grossinger Motors Arena in Bloomington. Danielle Turner competed at 100 lbs and Yami Aguirre battled through the tournament en route to a 4th place, All-State Finish. Yami Aguirre earned all-state for the 3rd consecutive year. Boys Basketball Season Ends in Regional Semi-Final!

The Boys Basketball Program had a great season at all three levels. The varsity boys ended the season 18-12 finishing over .500 for the second year in a row. The team was led by 7 seniors who all contributed to lead the Foxes to 44 wins in a two year span. The varsity Foxes had big wins over Top 25 ranked teams this year including Oswego East, Joliet West, Romeoville, West Aurora, St Ignatius, Metea Valley and Whitney Young. While the Foxes will lose 7 seniors from this year's team, the future is bright with a good junior class along with many sophomores to contribute to next year's team. The sophomore boys basketball team finished the season 20-7 while the Freshman teams combined for 17 wins.

The Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy is a pathway for multilingual students to earn college credits by meeting State requirements.

The language test to meet the Seal requirement is coming up. ALL students currently enrolled in Spanish or German classes level III or higher and those in Heritage Spanish I or II will be taking this test during the school day for FREE. Testing dates will vary depending on the course and will be communicated to students during class. The testing window will be March - May.

Current EL students who would like to take the Seal of Biliteracy test can also sign up to take the test for FREE. Students will need to fill out this form and return it to Mrs. Olsen by

Friday, March 8.

All other students who speak another language but are not currently enrolled in Spanish / German III or higher and are not a current EL student can choose to take the Seal of Biliteracy test. The student will need to fill out this form and return it to Mrs. Olsen. The cost will be \$20 and can be paid with cash or a check written out to Yorkville High School. Forms will be due by March 8.

Advanced Placement Testing Information for the 2023-2024 School Year

Students who are currently enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) Course are required to take the end of the year exam. Exams are administered at YHS and follow the College Board's national exam schedule. Students must test on the assigned exam day for their course. Please become familiar with the exam day schedule. 2024 Exam Schedule

Please note the test day highlights and special considerations:

- 1. The AP exam is required for all students participating in an AP course THIS school year.
- 2. Morning exams start at 7:30 am and afternoon exams start at 11:30 am.
- 3. All AP students will be pre-excused for testing and there is no need to call the attendance office on exam day.
- Students will primarily be testing in the Academy Back GYM unless noted on schedule. Students MUST park in their assigned parking spot. Students report directly to testing for morning exam sessions.
- 5. Students are responsible for transportation for afternoon exams. *Some exams run after 2:35 pm.
- 6. If your lunch period is missed due to testing you will be allowed to eat lunch prior to testing or after testing is completed for the day. No pass is needed. Lunch will be available early for PM testers in the main campus cafeteria (limited selection).
- 7. If your student has a morning and afternoon exam on one day they must participate in both exams and will be allowed to eat lunch in the testing room in between exams.
- 8. Students need to inform their AP teacher if they have more than one scheduled exam at the SAME time for either a morning or afternoon session prior to March 15th.
- 9. Students with College Board approved accommodations for AP testing must request accommodations prior to March 15th to Jeannine Pacetti at jpacetii@y115.org.
- 10. Students are expected to attend classes before or after testing. AP test proctors will not excuse students home for the day if classes are in session.

Students will need the following items on test day:

- 1. #2 Wooden Pencil, Calculator, Black or Blue Ink Pen
- 2. Student ID
- 3. College Board Identification Number. * This will be provided in advance by the AP Coordinator via the AP teacher. Students must come to EVERY exam with this number.
- 4. Water bottle or light lunch if participating in morning and afternoon testing on one day.

Seniors - The FAFSA is a Graduation Requirement! Don't Delay ~ Complete it Today!

Senior Families: Completing the FAFSA or the FAFSA waiver is an Illinois state high school graduation requirement—in order to graduate, you MUST complete it! The FAFSA is the *free* application for federal student aid, that must be completed to



qualify for federal grants, state grants, and institutional scholarships provided by colleges and universities. Remember, grant money is obtained by completing the FAFSA on a <u>first come</u>, <u>first served</u> basis! The FAFSA application is open now!

*all students must complete the FAFSA or the Waiver by May 1, 2024, as required by the state of Illinois for graduation.
