Recently, Yorkville High School earned National recognition as one of the Best High Schools in the United States according to the annual ranking published by the US News & World Report. YHS ranked among the top 15% of the nearly 25,000 public high schools in the nation! YHS also ranked in the top 18% of the high schools in the state! This is the fifth recognition in the past six years the school has received.



This prestigious recognition evaluates ALL high schools across the country across six comprehensive performance criteria that included: (1) College Readiness Index, (2) College Curriculum Breadth Index, (3) Math & Reading Proficiency, (4) Math & Reading Performance, (5) Underserved Student Populations, and (6) Graduation Rate. Yorkville / IMSA Swim COOP to Open Season!



National Honor Society (NHS) Applications are now being accepted!

What is the NHS?

The National Honor Society is a nationwide organization for high school students. Selection is based on four criteria: scholarship, leadership, service, and character. Each year students in grades 11 and 12 are invited to apply for membership, based on GPA. During the course of the school year, members are expected to actively participate in NHS sponsored service projects and attend meetings.

Students at Yorkville High School with a cumulative grade point of 3.5 (unweighted) or better, are eligible to pursue membership in the National Honor Society. However, scholarship is only one

of the qualifications that must be met, and it alone does not guarantee membership.

Applications are now open!

This completed APPLICATION PACKET MUST be returned to the Counseling Office by the end of the day


