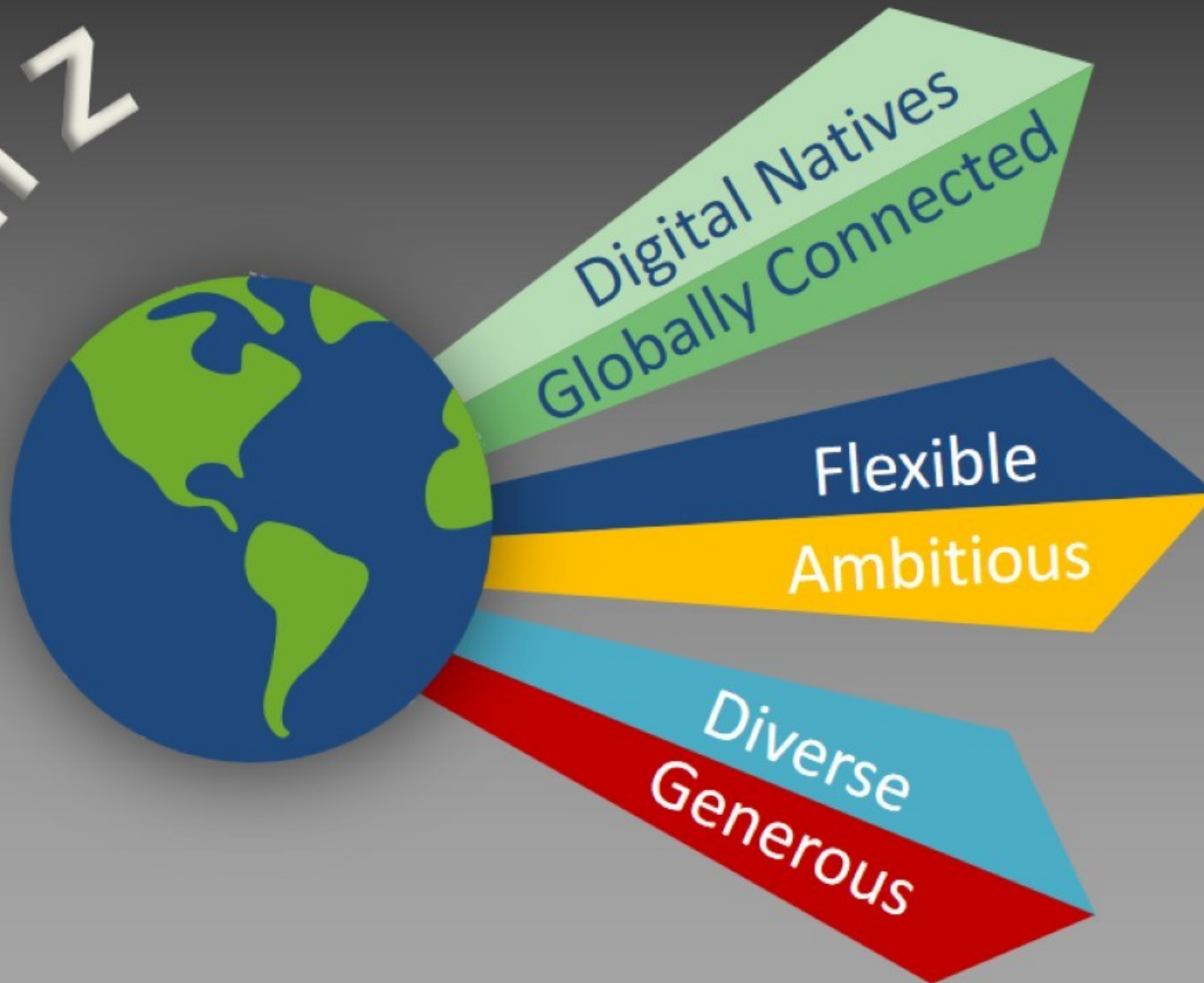
Key Areas of Celebrations

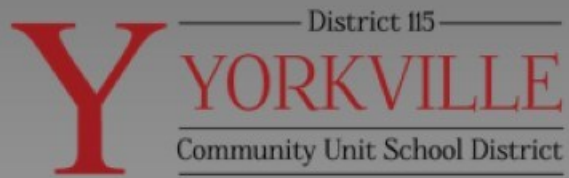

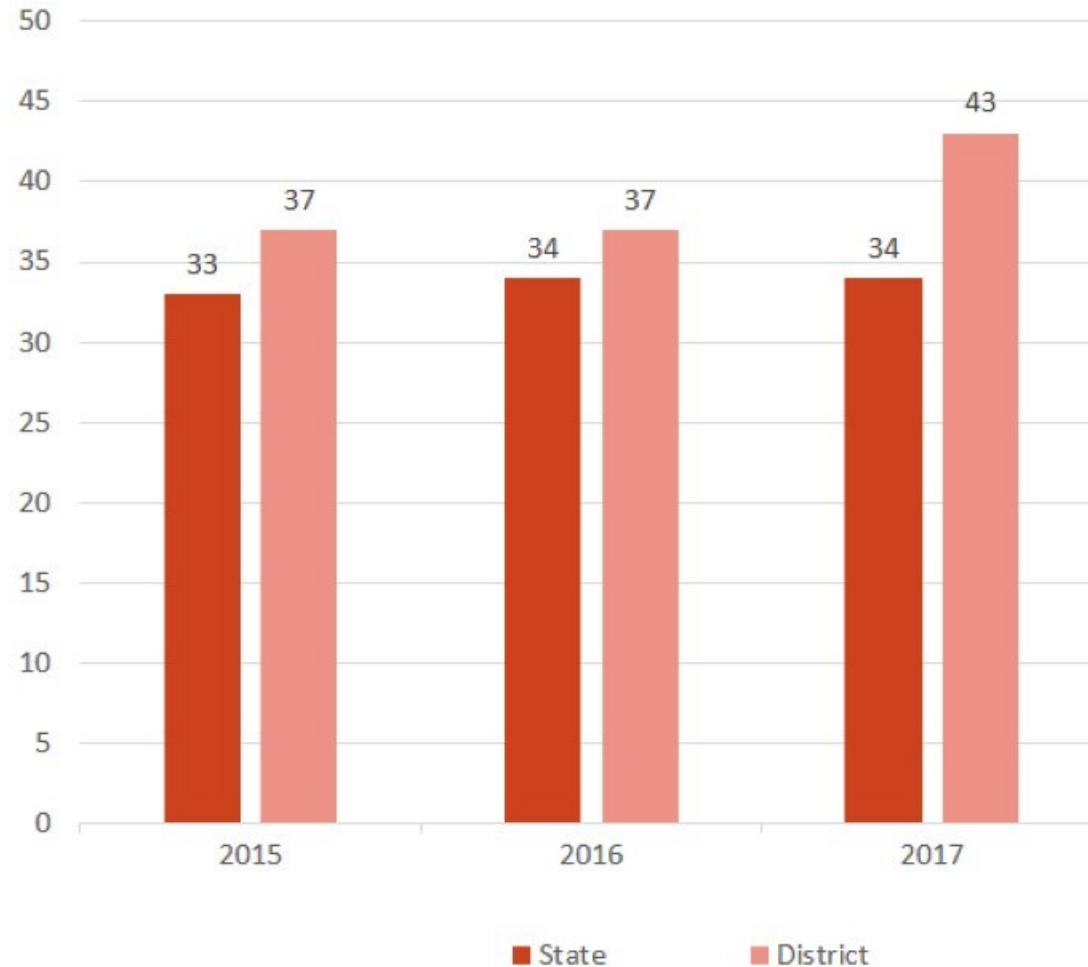

The graph illustrates the percentage of Yorkville students in grades 3-8 meeting or exceeding on the PARCC assessment compared to the state.

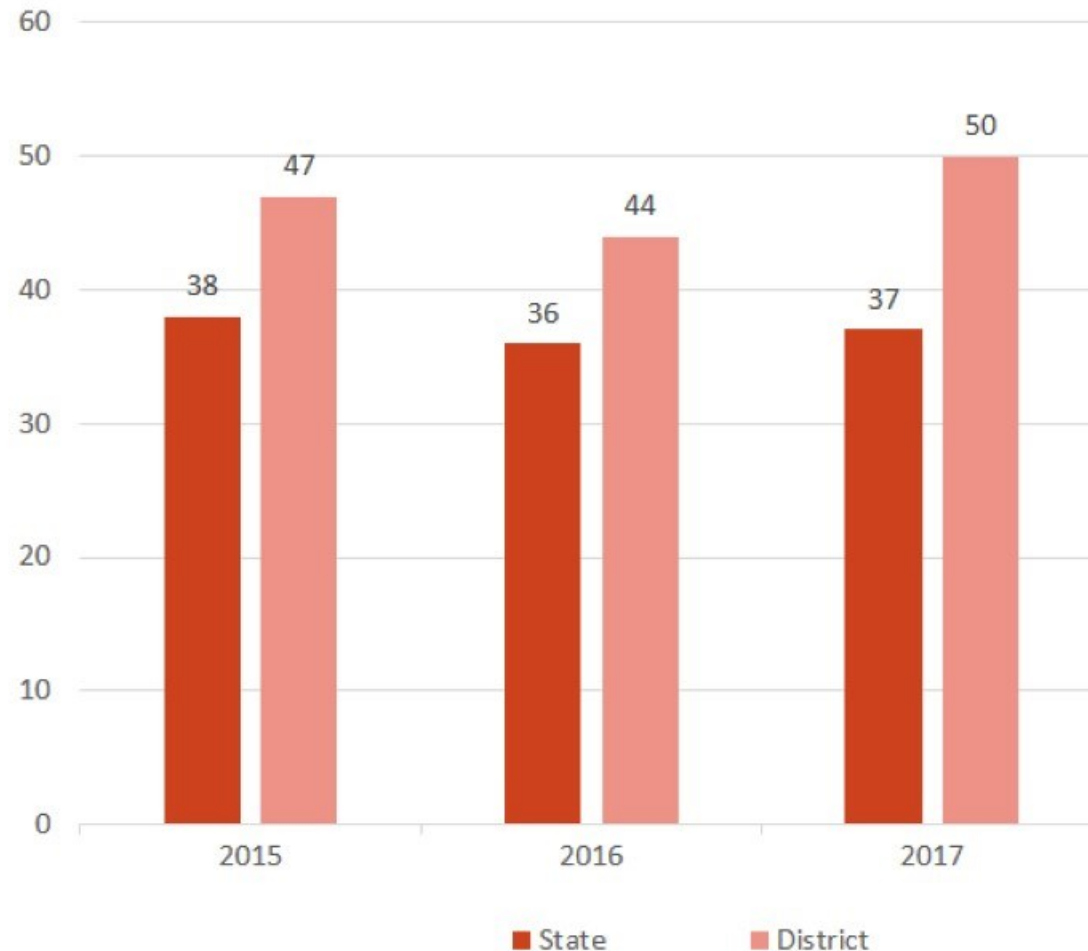
PARCC COMPOSITE

PARCC ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

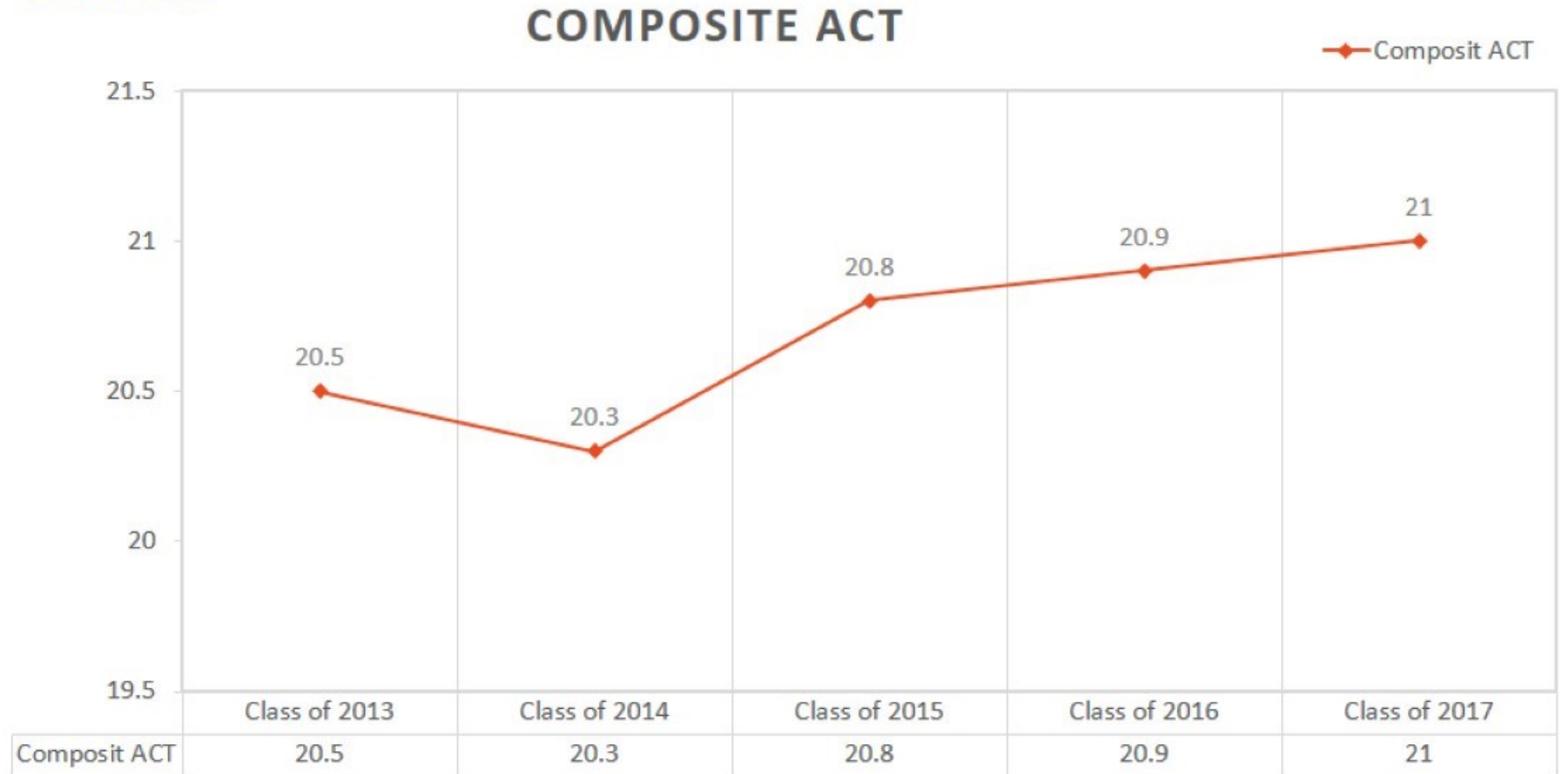

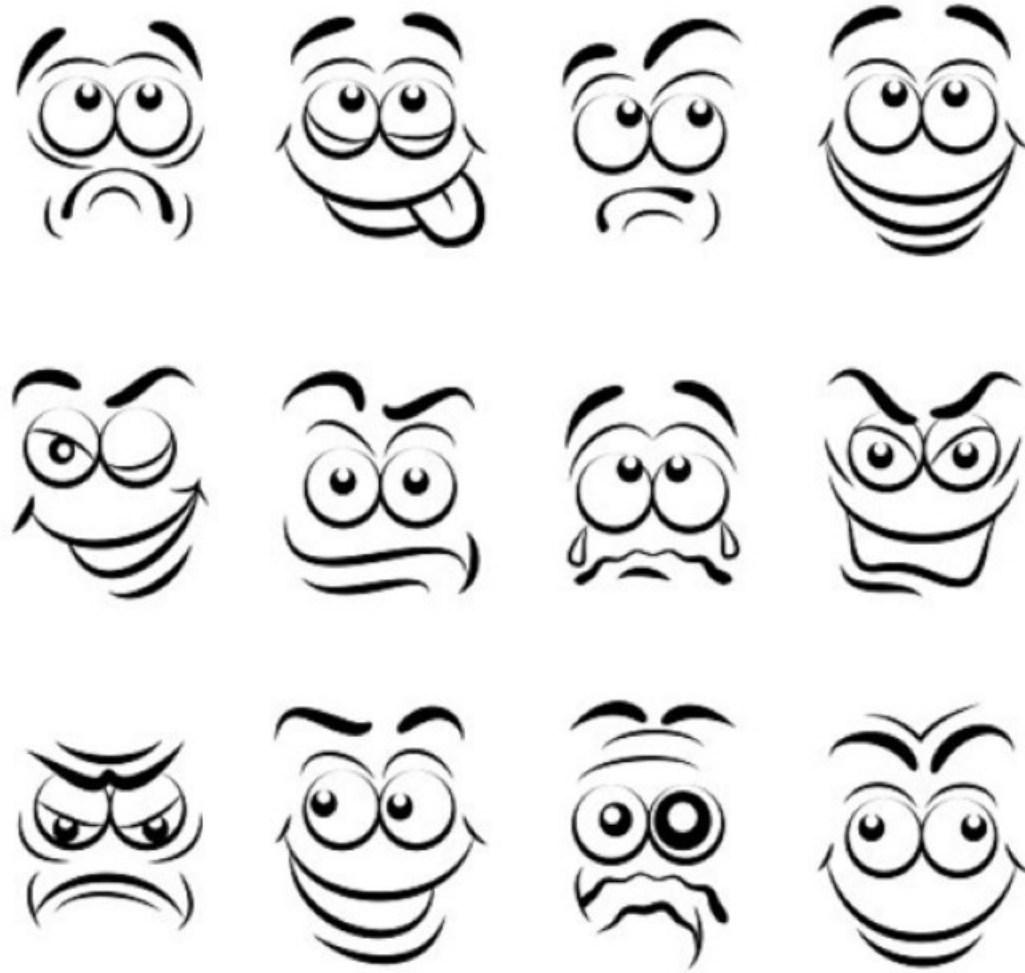
